


IMPORTANT NOTES:

- 1. To size cored hole, see component drawing P-55A.
- 2. Core hole through the floor to fit coupling.
- 3. Install a bead of ProSet Caulk around strainer body to waterproof.
- 4. Insert the coupling up through the cored hole, chip concrete down on top to fit the floor drain body and strainer.
- 5. Insert and solvent weld the proper length P-90 pipe into the bottom of the drain coupling.
- 6. Connect the no-hub P-trap to the P-90 pipe.
- 7. Install the S-01 hanger to the P-trap in a secure manner.

(OPTION) - A Snap-in Strainer can be used when the drain is not exposed to foot traffic or heavy loads.
